Lumps or swelling (especially in the neck, armpits, or groin).



Eye, white pupil in the eye, new-onset squint, visual loss, bruising, or swelling around the eye(s).



No appetite. Always tired. Constant tiredness or noticeable paleness.



Nausea that persists or vomiting without nausea.



Often gets headaches that persist, especially in the early morning or worsening over the day.



X Unexplained weight loss or fever and/or abdominal swelling.
